Synopsis: What price would you pay for paradise? And who would you be willing to take it from? The pristine archipelago of Bocas del Toro, Panama, attracts retirees and developers from the U.S. with its crystal-clear waters and its island culture. In *Para6so for Sale*, filmmaker, Anayansi Prado, returns to her homeland to document the effects the fast-growing migration is having on the local community.
